

# LARRY & MARTY MACH BEEF BOOSTERS

## Purpose:

The Larry and Marty Mach Beef Boosters program was established in September 2020. The program encourages local beef producers to donate their product to the Saunders County Catholic Schools Lunch Program.

The goal of the program is to increase the use of local products in our meals and to reduce food costs.

## How it Works:

Local producers donate a beef cow to Saunders Catholic Schools. The beef is then processed at a USDA certified locker plant, Wahoo Locker or ASC Lockers.

The beef is processed with monetary funds donated to the Beef Boosters program. Making the beef completely cost free to the school.

## Guidelines:

1. The donated cow must be fully fed out and ready for processing on the dates available (if the animal is not ready another date will be arranged).
  - We are not able to accept donations that are not ready for slaughter, too young or not at proper weight.
  - We ask donors to transport the animal to the locker, if they are unable arrangements will be made.
2. The beef will be processed into hamburger, with the prime cuts of prime rib and brisket cut out and later auctioned off to replenish processing funds.
3. Cash donations will be deposited into the Larry and Marty Mach Beef Boosters Processing Fund and used to pay the butchering and packaging fee for the beef.
4. All donation receipts will be sent from the Development Office.
