*Please go to www.ACT.org to register for a date and location to take the ACT. FYI – the first time you register to take the ACT, you need to have about 1 hour to dedicate to the process. It does take some time!! If you miss the registration deadline, you can still register by the 'late registration' date for an additional cost. As a general rule, colleges do not accept ACT scores past the December ACT date of the student's senior year. Plan accordingly!

*Bishop Neumann currently has a subscription to the online On To College website – the John Baylor ACT test prep. Our subscription will expire July 21, 2023. Students who are taking the ACT in June or July can access the info by going to www.ontocollege.com. They will need to get their user name and password from Mrs. Chvatal.

*Mrs. Sladky has ACT workbooks and materials available for student use. The Bishop Neumann library also has some materials available for check out.

*Bishop Neumann will again offer our ACT Prep Course leading up to the December ACT and the April ACT. The cost of the course is \$45, and is geared toward junior and senior students. Students are given a practice ACT test to complete and then Mr. Gilman, Mr. Rezac, and Mrs. Sladky give instruction on the Science, English, and Math portions of the ACT. Students are also given tips on managing their time while taking the ACT, advice on how to be successful on each of the 4 test portions, and reminders of things to bring to the ACT. Mrs. Sladky will have a sign up for the ACT Prep Course in her classroom and more info will come out in the bulletin before the course is offered.
