

The Bob Chvatal Memorial Scholarship

Bob was a 1978 Bishop Neumann alumni and a member of the first football team to earn a State Championship. He graduated from SCC in Milford with a degree in Plumbing. If you knew Bob, you knew he was a person who could fix anything and everything. He carried a “tool box” in his pockets and a heart of service for others. For 25 years, he was the Facilities Manager for Wahoo Public Schools. He served 32 years on the Wahoo Volunteer Fire Department. He helped whoever needed it, whenever he could, and always with a promise to do more if needed. This scholarship has been established to continue his legacy of helping others.

The Bob Chvatal Memorial Scholarship will be awarded to a graduating senior of Bishop Neumann High School. This \$500 scholarship will be awarded directly to the student upon proof of enrollment in their first semester.

Scholarship Requirements:

2. Must plan on enrolling as a full-time student at a 2 or 4 year institution
3. Attach a resume of high school activities and achievements, including part-time jobs and community activities
4. Complete required essay
5. Submit one letter of recommendation from a faculty member
