### **Scholarship Guidelines:**

- Requires completed application. Handwritten applications will not be considered.
- Awarded annually to a graduating senior
- 1 or 2 scholarships valued up to \$2500
- Available for 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter/2<sup>nd</sup> semester of freshman year in college
- Recipient must maintain full-time status (according to college policy) and a GPA of 2.5
- Funds disbursed upon submission of 1<sup>st</sup> quarter/1<sup>st</sup> semester grades and evidence of continued full-time enrollment to the Bishop Neumann Guidance Office.

### **Selection process:**

- Application submitted to Guidance office by March 1st
- Family to approve final scholarship recipients
