

## 2025 EDUCATOR OF THE YEAR NOMINATIONS

In 2022, the Diocese of Lincoln began a new tradition of honoring outstanding educators in our Catholic schools. The Diocese of Lincoln Educator of the Year Awards are now presented annually at the Bishop's Saints & Scholars Dinner, held in the fall.

The 2025 Educator of the Year Award Winners will be announced during Teacher Appreciation Week (May 5-May 9). Recipients will receive their awards at the Bishop's Saints & Scholars Dinner in the fall on October 12, 2025.
